Pacemaker ICD ILR Evaluation and Programming - Successful completion of specialized training in device evaluation and programming with a member of the arrhythmia team that is Heart Rhythm Society Certified Cardiac Device SpecialistAND- Three months of weekly clinic sessions which will include didactic teaching session and supervised hands on sessions. Renewal - Minimum 20 cases required during the past 2 years]
