Required Qualifications

Education/Training

Successful completion of an ACGME or AOA-accredited residency/fellowship in preventive medicine/occupational health or foreign equivalent training.

AND

Current certification or active participation in the examination process leading to certification in internal medicine by the American Board of Preventive Medicine/Occupational Health or the American Osteopathic Board of Preventive Medicine or foreign equivalent training/board.

Clinical Experience (Reappointment)

Management of minimum 100 Core outpatients required in the past two years. Active participation in ABIM Maintenance of Certification Program (if time-limited certification)
