

Privileges in Plastic Surgery Service

SAMPLE

Required Qualifications

Education/Training

Successful completion of an ACGME or AOA-accredited residency/fellowship in plastic surgery or foreign equivalent training.

AND

Current certification or active participation in the examination process leading to certification in Plastic Surgery by the American Board of Plastic Surgery or foreign equivalent training/board.

AND

Documentation or attestation of the performance of at least 100 plastic surgery procedures on inpatients or outpatients as the attending physician (or senior resident), at a fully accredited Ambulatory Surgery Facility, during the past two years.

Additional Credentialing Criteria (Initial and Reappointment)

In accordance with Hospital Sedation Policy and completion of the SHC sedation exam taken every 2 years

Use of Fluoroscopy Equipment- Valid Radiology Supervisor and Operator Certificate or

Fluoroscopy Supervisor and Operator Permit Required Teaching appointment to work in SHC outpatient clinics

Membership and privileges at LPCH to admit, treat patients 14 years old and younger

To be granted Central Venous Catheter Insertion must complete "Getting to Zero" educational

module

Clinical Experience (Initial) Complex hand surgery - Completion of plastic surgery training with documentation of special

emphasis in this area and/or Certificate of added qualification in Hand Surgery.

Complex craniofacial surgery - Completion of plastic surgery training with documentation of

special emphasis in this area and/or fellowship training in craniofacial surgery.

Use of surgical laser - Record of training for specific laser used.

Clinical Experience (Reappointment)

Minimum 100 plastic surgeryCore procedures required during the past 2 years Minimum 40 procedures required during the past 2 years - Complex hand surgery

Minimum 10 cases required during the past 2 years - Complex craniofacial surgery; Use of

surgical laser; Central Venous Catheter Insertion

	Privileges to admit, evaluate, diagnose, consult, perform history and physical exam, and perform surgical procedures for patients presenting with both congenital and acquired defects of the body's soft tissue.	
	Congenital defects of the head and neck, including clefts of the lip and palate, and craniofacial surgery	
	Cranio-maxillofacial trauma, including fractures of the mandible and maxilla	
	Aesthetic (cosmetic) surgery of the head and neck, trunk and extremities	
	Plastic surgery of the breast	
	Surgery of the head/upper extremities	
	Plastic surgery of the lower extremities	
	Plastic surgery of the congenital and acquired defects of the trunk and genitalia	
	Burn management, acute and reconstructive	
	Microsurgical techniques applicable to plastic surgery	
	Reconstruction by tissue transfer, including flaps and grafts	
	Surgery of benign and malignant lesions of the skin and soft tissues
