Dr. Bohman has been associated with Stanford Medicine since arriving at SHC in 1981 for his residency in internal medicine. He subsequently practiced for five years at Santa Clara Valley Medical Center, followed by two decades as a community physician at SHC and in the surrounding communities.

Over the past ten years he has become increasingly engaged in SHC and UHA medical leadership, serving as SHC's first elected Chief of Staff from 2008-2011 and subsequently as Associate Chief Medical Officer. He has developed an interest and expertise in clinical quality and safety; performance improvement in the context of a learning healthcare system; the interrelationships between clinician wellness/professional fulfillment and healthcare system performance; and population health – all areas that are directly related to the goals and the challenges facing our UHA practices. Dr. Bohman will continue to serve as an Associate Chief Medical Officer for Stanford Hospital & Clinics, focusing on the development of the improvement and management capabilities of the Stanford Operating System.
