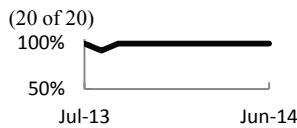

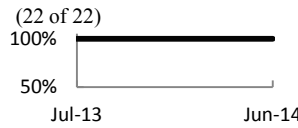

% of Core Measure Perfect Care Performance

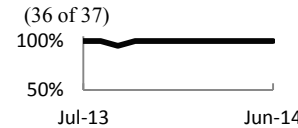
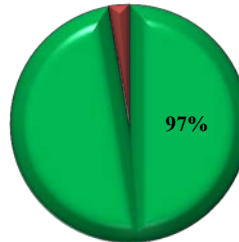

PNA— Pneumonia

⇒Patient was renal dose q 48 hr and received first dose of abx PTA

SCIP—Surgical Care Improvement Project

⇒MD documentation for reasons extending antibiotics past 24 hours needed

⇒SCIP Patients need to receive appropriate antibiotic

STK—Stroke

⇒STK patients (with AFIB or AFIB hx) must receive an anticoagulant medication w/in 48 hours of arrival and at discharge or need MD documentation of a contraindication

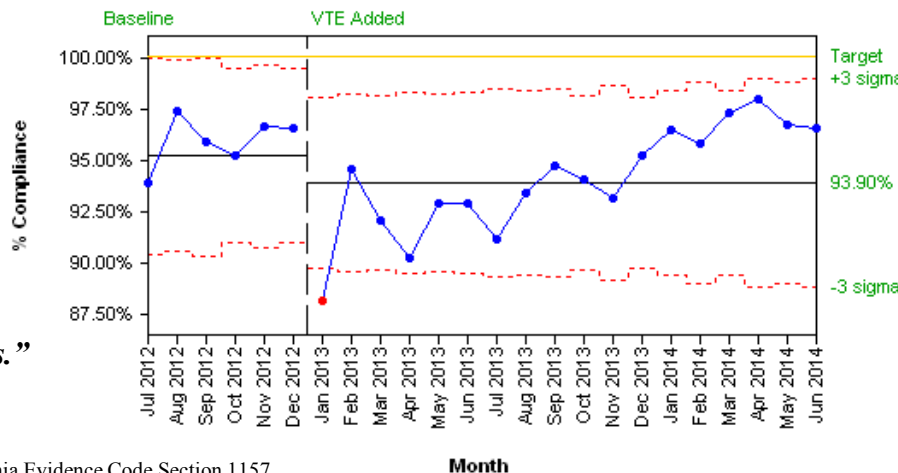
⇒STK patients must be assessed by the Rehab team or contraindication must be documented

VTE - Venous Thrombo-Embolism

⇒VTE patients (all) must receive VTE prophylaxis by Hospital Day 2 or need MD documentation of contraindications for both chemical and mechanical VTE prophylaxis
